January 18th Cast Update

We're almost a week away from our first preview performance, so I'd like to make sure you know what will take place over the next week. All of this will be announced as we get closer, but I'd rather you have it in print as well. – Mr. Cloonan

Wednesday and Thursday, 1/19-1/20: FULL CAST practice from 3:00-6:00.

We'll start adding in some of the leads' costumes and try to run through the show at least 2 more complete times off-book with some notes after.

Saturday, 1/22: MANDATORY EVERYONE Tech Rehearsal.

9:00AM Tech Crew and Leads (including Knight #1 and Knight #2, plus the 3 named Ladies) report
10:00AM Full Cast reports

We run through the complete show stopping to fix lighting cues, rework scene changes, mics, etc.
Bring a bagged lunch – please do not order or have food brought to you, as I don't know exactly when we'll break for lunch. We finish at 2:00PM

Monday, 1/24: FULL DRESS REHEARSAL 3:00-8:00PM with Dinner Break

Report to the auditorium immediately after school to get into make-up and costume. We'll do a short warm-up around 3:15 and begin the show at 3:30. At 5:00, we'll break for dinner down in the cafeteria for the food provided by your parents. By 6:00, we'll be back in places for another full run of the show, give some notes, then walk over to the LGI Room to sing "Song of Love" for the School Board at 7:30. Once we're finished, you'll have about 15 minutes to get out of costume and make-up and put the auditorium back together for tomorrow's rehearsal.

Tuesday, 1/25: DRESS REHEARSAL: 3:00-6:00PM; PICTURE NIGHT 6:00-6:30PM

Please tell your parents that tonight is the night to bring cameras. Once we're done with our rehearsal and notes at 6:00, we'll invite parents and families to come in and we'll pose you in various combinations with different parts of the set up.

Wednesday, 1/26: 5th-7th GRADE PREVIEW – NO AFTER SCHOOL REHEARSAL

Report to the auditorium immediately following homeroom. We'll be finished before the end of 4th period so you can change and report to 5th period.

Thursday, 1/27: 8th & 9th GRADE PREVIEW

Some leads will come early for make-up, but all should report to the auditorium at the end of 6th period to get into costume and make-up. 9th grade cast members may report a few minutes before 7th period to the cafeteria to get their lunch and bring it to the pit to eat. We'll perform for the 8th and 9th graders periods 8 and 9 and finish the show with enough time for you to change out of costume before getting on the bus.

SHOW NIGHTS: 1/27-1/29

Report at 5:30 for costume and make-up. By no later than 6:00, leads should be on stage for a mic check. We do a full warm-up at 6:10, provide notes, and clear the house by 6:30 when we open the doors to the public. Shows begin at 7:00. After the curtain call, make sure all of your costume pieces are in your garment bag and put back on the rack before leaving. The Cast Party begins after the last night's performance is wrapped up.
