### **Fees**

Please insist that students leave cell phones turned off and in their coat pockets or backpacks. They may not bring them on stage with them.

**Performance**

Parents are welcome to attend the end of the day concert. This is an informal performance and there will not be a ticket fee at the door. The entire day is a workshop environment.

**Student Attire**

Students are asked to wear nice school clothes. They are not going to be expected to wear black pants and shirt w/ tie. However, ask students to keep in mind that there will be an audience of teacher and parents watching the final sing through at 3PM. Ask students to be conservative and remember school dress code standards.
